


Following its two successful

Caimin O'Brien will lecture on

'Monumental Kilbixy – a survey of the Archaeological landscape around the medieval settlement of Kilbixy, Co. Westmeath.'

Caimin is a state archaeologist working for the Archaeological Survey of Ireland (ASI). His duties include the management of the Sites & Monuments Record (SMR) for County Westmeath. Caimin is responsible for updating the Record with new information; the online database for County Westmeath currently has 4,708 records for the county.

Dr Finbar McCormick will lecture on 'The Kilbixy mausoleum and the Malone family.'

Finbar taught Archaeology in Queens University, Belfast, for many years before retiring in 2019. He has published widely and is currently researching Irish holy wells.

Finbar is a Trustee of the Follies Trust and in 2022 undertook a survey of the vault of the Malone mausoleum.
