**Caimin O'Brien will lecture on  
'Monumental Kilbixy – a survey of the Archaeological landscape around the medieval settlement of Kilbixy, Co. Westmeath.'**

Caimin is a state archaeologist working for the Archaeological Survey of Ireland (ASI). His duties include the management of the Sites & Monuments Record (SMR) for County Westmeath. Caimin is responsible for updating the Record with new information; the online database for County Westmeath currently has 4,708 records for the county.

**Dr Finbar McCormick will lecture on  
'The Kilbixy mausoleum and the Malone family.'**

Finbar taught Archaeology in Queens University, Belfast, for many years before retiring in 2019. He has published widely and is currently researching Irish holy wells.
